Dear Luca, Dear colleagues of the Steering Committee,

as member of the External Advisory Board of the Skybelt project I am now writing you with few comments arisen during a second meeting I recently had online with Luca. At the time of our first meeting, more than one year ago, Luca reported me the selected modules in Asian Partner Universities together with the details of their syllabuses. In general, I found almost all the modules very pertinent with the topic of the project. The few that were apparently less in line with the topic could actually result in an added value for the competences and skills of the new engineers with enhanced knowledge in the topic of the project. - ✓ please try to have an impact at all levels. Hence, in those institutions where the modules at master/PhD levels are not much try to do your best in extending the impact also for the students at these levels.
